an envelope









Fold one of the four corners of your square to the opposite corner, then unfold.



Repeat using the other corner.

Open it up into a square again.






Now you have an envelope!



You can write a letter




and send it to your best friend.

Fold one corner of the square over. Now you have a triangle!




Fold the triangle in half and mark the middle.

Fold over two small triangles (away from the middle line) to make the dog's pointy ears.




Put a face on your dog!

Fold the square in half. Then unfold.



Fold the opposite sides to the red centre line.



Now you have a wardrobe!


Open your wardrobe with a key and put some shirts

and a pair of trousers

Go on!




into it.

Fold one corner of the square over.

Now you have a triangle!



Fold **one** of the two top corners over the black dotted line.



Put the triangle on the table with the central fold pointing up (like a tent).

Fold one corner over to the top.



Flip the piece over.
Fold the other top corner in the same way.



Then take the other corner and fold it to the opposite edge.




Go on!

Try to fill something to drink in it.


Now you have a cup!








a house







Fold the square in half. Then unfold.



Put the square on the table with the red centre line pointing up.

Fold the two edges on top to the red center line.



Now you have a house!


If you like you can put windows,

or other things in your






a frog








Fold a square into three long rectangles!



Draw eyes on the frog.




Fold the long rectangle into fours, making a "W"shape.



Cut out a long tongue from a piece of red paper and glue the end of it in the frog`s mouth.



This "W"shape will be the frog.




thumb

Put your thumb in the frog`s lower jaw and put your other fingers in the upper jaw. You now have a frog with a VERY big mouth.
