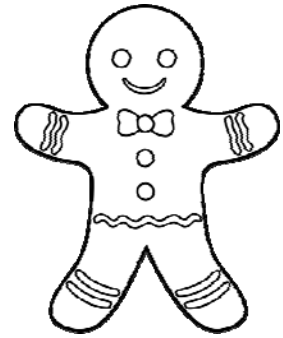


The Gingerbread Man
